Major Career Accomplishments - what I got done

Product / Project Ownership and Management

- Set up a Dependency Management system for software development that emcompassed team work within a division, but also was able of track work being done by and for teams outside the division without unnecessary involvement in the process.
- Wrote and updated Program Documents, including a Program Plan and Program Overview for a Unified Control Plane project involving five different products and software development teams
- Worked with stakeholders, management, and developers to revamp organizational Scrum practices that were out
 of date, inflexible, and ineffective. Developed a better ceremony cadence, and was able to reduce meeting time on
 a weekly basis. Organized wider retrospectives to facilitate more comminication between teams and to break
 down silos.
- First product owner in company history (company was eight years old when I was assigned the role) of two
 independent teams working in the same circle, able to get huge backlog organized foster company-wide
 stakeholder / developer communications, streamlined the development process, and providing a better sense of
 priority while emphasizing client needs.
- Developed communication framework to encompass entire project life cycle from initial planning through release, and into maintenance. Stakeholder preferences and needs were taken into consideration, resulting in much smoother workflow with better understanding of project status.
- Assisted on-boarding and training junior and mid-level developers, establishing and enforcing best practices and coding standards.
- Directed implementation of an agile-based workflow for teams on three different but related projects. No organized workflow existed previously; new workflow showed vastly improved development cycle times.
